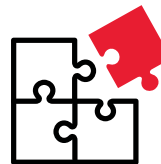

Residency Program Overview

Our sports residency program runs from August through September of the following year. We take 2-4 residents for each location, depending on our clinic availability, candidates, and mentors. Our program is offered in: Birmingham, AL; Charleston, SC; Chicago, IL; Greenville, SC; Phoenix, AZ; and Tacoma, WA.

Residents treat patients on average for 32 hours per week with an additional 4 hours of mentorship, 4 hours of sport coverage, 3-4 hours of specialty practice observation, and 4 hours of didactic/Journal club each week.

Our full pay residency is valued at \$15,000, and we provide full coverage of that cost with a 2-year commitment to ATI after successfully completing the residency program. Completion can be fulfilled any location with an open position in the company.

Admission Requirements

Residents must be licensed clinicians when they start the residency program in the state where they are enrolled in the program. We are looking for candidates who are willing to learn, have a strong passion for sports, are flexible, and demonstrate effective communication and teamwork.

When clinics are located in close proximity, residents rotate between sites to gain exposure to diverse patient populations and mentorship styles. In instances where travel between clinics is not feasible, we provide alternative opportunities to ensure residents receive guidance and development from multiple mentors.
